



Grooming Brushes

ANSWERS

A – Hoof Pick – for cleaning out horses' feet

B – Body Brush – removes dried sweat and dust from the clipped, stabled horse

C – Dandy Brush – removes dried sweat and mud from field kept and unclipped horses

D – Plastic Curry Comb – cleans body brush

E – Rubber Curry Comb – excellent at removing winter coat, used in circular motions

F – Metal Curry Comb – only ever to clean brushes

G – Sweat Scraper – removes excess water from horse's body

H – Mane/Tail Comb – used to pull mane and tail and to help whilst plaiting

I – Sponge – one for eyes and nose, one for sheath/udders

J – Massage Pad – improves circulation on large muscle areas

K – Stable Rubber – gives a finishing polish to coat

L – Hoof Oil – light oil to shine and condition hooves
